Training Policy
for
Demand Occupations

Proposed training must:

Prepare individuals for employment in high growth occupational areas which include the following **WIB identified priority sectors**:

- Health care
- Advanced manufacturing
- Renewable energy/green technology
- Business/office/computer technology
- Tourism
- Transportation/distribution
- Construction trades

And

In occupations listed in the [**NYSDOL Occupational Employment Statistics Survey \(OES\) \(Capital Region\)***](#), and

Employment Prospects on OES Survey must be listed as **Favorable or Very Favorable**, and

Be completed in 2 years or less, and

OES Survey median wage for the occupation must be at least 80% of the Adult or Dislocated Worker performance standard wage, and

CRT provider must be on the ETP list (Trade Act exceptions may apply)

If OJT, in addition to demand occupation requirements, must comply with OJT Policies and Procedures.
